Promoter has the right to limit entries due to cattle availability &/or to make changes due to unforeseen circumstances. Membership or Weekend Pass required to ride.

WAIVERS & FORMS MUST BE COMPLETED TO RIDE

<u>Definitions & Restrictions—Sorting & Penning</u>

- Riders are responsible to know/understand the WTPC Rules which can be found on the WTPC website.
- Participants must change (1) rider on each team in all classes unless drawn as a duplicate.
- Open Penning and Sorting classes are Pick/Draw classes, with a minimum of 1 picked team and 1 drawn team.
- Amateur & Novice Penning and Sorting Classes are Pick/Draw classes, with a minimum of 1 picked and a maximum of 2 picked teams, and a minimum of 1 draw team.
- Open Limited: Must have AM or NOV rating—all 3 riders must meet criteria. Open Limited also required to ride minimum of 1 draw team.
- **Green Novice**: 1st or 2nd year penning or sorting and/or have less than \$200 in earnings, have a Rating Committee approval.
 - Green Novice Penning: Green novice penning will be drawn with 2 green novice riders and 1 open, amateur, or advanced Nov rider for the first 3 events. After the first 3 events 3 green novice riders will be drawn per team. Duplicate Green Novice teams will be accepted if drawn that way.
 - Green Novice Sorting: Green novice sorting will be two green novice riders, with coaching by an open or amateur rider. Green novice riders have the option to pick 1 team and draw 3, or to draw all 4 teams. Duplicate Green Novice teams will be accepted if drawn that way.
- Separate Penning and Sorting points will be kept for each rider.
- Must be a WTPC member in good standing and participate in at least 70% or more of all Sorting events to be eligible for year end Sorting Awards and at least 70% of all Penning events to be eligible for year end Penning Awards.
